Medical Respite at Jefferson Terrace Day of Admit Checklist

☐ COVID SCREEN

ALL PATIENTS MUST HAVE A **RESULTED NEGATIVE COVID PCR TEST** WITHIN 24 HOURS OF ADMISSION TO RESPITE

- COVID (+) pts must complete 10 days of isolation from first date positive per HMC infection control
 policy
- Exception: COVID-positive PCR in past 90 days

■ MEDS

- Scheduled meds: 30-day supply of all scheduled medications
- Opioids (if applicable)
 - o Three days ONLY of opioids
 - o Bowel meds needed
- Intranasal Narcan
- PRNs: Defer to discharging provider
- **Diabetes management** (if appliable)
 - o Please include any applicable DM supplies in discharge meds, included, but not limited to:
 - Blood glucose monitor
 - Lancets
 - Testing strips
 - Insulin pens preferred
- Pts with insurance coverage:
 - Discharge meds should be filled at the discharging hospital prior to patient leaving discharging facility
 - In some cases, discharge meds may be sent to the HMC Discharge Pharmacy only if patient's insurance is contracted with Harborview's Discharge Pharmacy
 - Faxing hard scripts to HMC pharmacy: (f) 206.744.5945
 - The discharging facility must provide full supply of all discharge medications and patient must bring these with them to Respite

■ WOUND CARE: SEVEN DAYS of any needed wound care supplies sent with patient
☐ DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT: send patients with any needed durable medical equipment
(wheelchair, walker, braces, orthotics)

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□ DISCHARGE SUMMARY

DISCHARGE SUMMARY MUST BE **AVAILABLE** AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO PATIENT LEAVING THE DISCHARGING FACILITY

- Respite Screeners can access the d/c summary in CareEverywhere ONLY after the attending physician
 has signed it
- If we cannot access the d/c summary electronically, please be prepared to fax it
- The d/c summary is utilized during the respite admission process

☐ FOLLOW UP APPOINTMENTS

- Specialty follow-up appointments must be scheduled with a confirmed date/time
 - Infectious Disease At least 2 days prior to end of IV antibiotics
 - o Heart Failure cardiology follow-up no later than seven days after admission to respite
 - o Appointment for suture, staple, or drain removal
- MAT
 - Methadone: established appointment for day after admission to Respite, or a means of Direct
 Observed Therapy at discharging facility as bridge until the established appointment
 - Suboxone: established appointment with a Suboxone provider. Patient must be discharged with adequate supply of Suboxone to get the patient to the established appointment
- Any recommended specialty care per the discharge summary

☐ ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS NEEDED (FAX: 206-744-5233)

- PICC or midline documentation (for all pts admitting with home infusion)
- POLST (if applicable)
